



## The Rumely DoAll Tractor

### *Convertible Type—In Four-Wheel Form*

ONE of the greatest needs on the small farm is a tractor that will handle every job from plowing to harvesting. The Advance-Rumely DoAll tractor is just such a machine.

It was brought out in answer to a wide-spread demand from the row-crop farmer for a compact, powerful, easily handled tractor that could be quickly converted from a four-wheel tractor to a cultivating machine and vice-versa, and one that would be equally efficient in either form.

In tractor form it is a light, sturdy, compact, four-wheeled tractor of simple and efficient design, is as easy to operate as an auto and can be manipu-

lated in places where larger and heavier tractors would be at a disadvantage.

The DoAll will on the average displace from four to eight horses, depending on the nature of the farm, and do the work in much less time at a much greater profit.

The DoAll is just what its name implies—the “Handy Andy” of the farm. On the drawbar it will plow, list, disc, harrow, seed, cultivate; pull binder, potato digger, cotton planter, or any hauling job. On the belt it will grind feed, thresh, saw wood, shell corn, pump water, and a hundred and one other jobs that require power transmission through a belt.
