THE Advance-Rumely DoAll tractor is quickly and easily converted into a cultivating unit—making the easiest, quickest and cheapest device for cultivating known.

It is a pleasure to operate the DoAll cultivator—it steers as easily as an auto, “turns in its tracks” at the ends of the rows and travels at a speed that covers a lot of ground in a short time.

When in cultivator form the drive wheels are hinged on pivot pins allowing them to effect the steering of the machine along the rows.

In addition, the cultivating shovels are mounted in front of the operator, and are controlled inde-

pendently of the tractor in the same way as the shovels on horse-drawn cultivators.

The exceptionally high clearance provided allows for the cultivation of very tall crops. In fact, shoulder high corn can be successfully cultivated without injury.

The castor type rear wheel and the powerful steering brakes allow for quick turns at the end of the rows without damage to the crop.

One man or boy with the DoAll can cultivate from two to three times as much as with horses or mules, do a better job—and easier—at only a part of the cost.
